Mark L. Harvey Legacy Recognition

- 1.1** The nominee must be a current member of AAHPERD and state AHPERD and have experience as a full-time teacher supervisor or administrator in the field of HPERD for a minimum of ten years.
- 1.2** The nominee must have demonstrated accomplishments in the following areas:
- Mentor (teacher, coach and/or supervisor)
 - Courage (ability to overcome adversity)
 - Leadership (involvement in state, district and/or national professional associations)
 - Stewardship (community, volunteerism and/or faith involvement)

Nomination Criteria:

1. The merits of the nominee are described in a narrative (maximum of 150 words for each category listed above). The narrative is to be written using one-inch margins, Times New Roman font 12, and should accompany the nomination form.
 2. Two letters of recommendation must accompany the nomination form.
 3. Vitas or resumes are NOT accepted.
 4. Current AAHPERD and state AHPERD membership is required.
 5. A head-and-shoulder photo of the nominee is to be submitted with the nomination.
- 1.3** One award per year may be presented at the annual District convention.
- 1.4** The official nomination form for each Mark L. Harvey Legacy Recognition Award candidate, along with the requested photo and two letters of recommendation must be forwarded to the District Recognition Committee Chair (electronically) by November 12. - 1.5** The same rating system that is currently used for the Kinderfather Award and the Honor Award shall be used for the Harvey Award.
