To assist and encourage the Southwest District states and Guam to develop leadership opportunities for student members, SWD AAHPERD is offering each state a grant of up to \$1000. Collaboration projects between states can apply for funds equaling \$1000.00 per state involved. Funds requested must be matched by state organizations.

Guidelines:

- The grant request needs to go through the state AHPERD association.
- States need to provide evidence that the seed grant money will be spent on student leadership development within the HPERD profession.
- SWD must see “fruits of your labor”. The state(s) provide evidence that students involved with the grant project contribute to the mission of SWD and/or AAHPERD.
