## Student Delegate Application - 2012 Alliance Assembly

**AAHPERD** seeks five undergraduate or graduate students to serve as delegates or alternates to the Alliance Assembly at the 2012 National Convention & Exposition in Boston.

The Alliance Assembly is a governing body of AAHPERD, with approximately 250 representatives from all states, districts, territories, and national associations. Student delegates will represent all student members of AAHPERD with the authority to vote on behalf of all students.

### Delegate Term and Membership Requirements

All delegates will serve for one calendar year beginning January 1, 2012 and ending December 31, 2012. To serve as an Assembly delegate, students must hold a current membership in the Alliance and must have held such membership for at least one continuous year immediately prior to election or appointment to the Alliance Assembly (**i.e., for 2012, membership must have commenced on or before December 31, 2010**). A lapse in membership at any time will disqualify a member from serving.

### Alliance Assembly Meetings

All delegates must attend the Assembly session scheduled at the national convention in Boston on Saturday, March 17, 2012 from 2:00 – 6:00 p.m. Delegates will receive a packet of information to review prior to the convention.

Other meetings will be conducted during the week of convention to allow time for delegates to discuss the critical issues being presented at the Assembly. **All delegates are encouraged to attend these important meetings (i.e., AAHPERD Town Forum and Alliance Assembly Forum)**. A preliminary schedule for the week is provided below (venues have not yet been determined and all dates and times are subject to change):

AAHPERD Town Forum	<b>Wednesday, March 14</b> 10:15 – 11:30 a.m.	The forum will focus on the organization's future directions, and issues facing the Alliance and its national associations.
Alliance Assembly Forum	<b>Friday, March 16</b> 4:30 – 5:30 p.m.	The forum will allow time for delegates to discuss the critical issues being presented at the Assembly in an informal setting. The Board of Governors will be available during this time to answer questions regarding the Assembly agenda.
Delegate Check-in	<b>Saturday, March 17</b> 1:00 – 2:00 p.m.	All delegates and any alternates serving as proxies are required to check in prior to the Assembly meeting.
Alliance Assembly Meeting	<b>Saturday, March 17</b> 2:00 – 6:00 p.m.	This is one official meeting (two sessions) of the Alliance Assembly. The primary purpose of the First Session of the meeting is to make certain that the delegates understand the issues upon which they will be required to take action during the Second Session.
