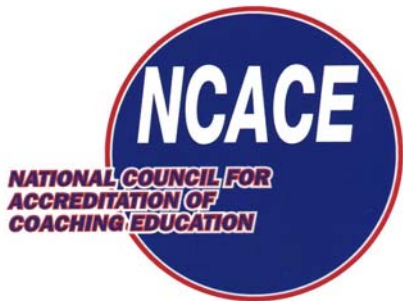

Coaching Conferences of Interest

2012 National Coaching Conference (NCC 2012)

The annual NCC, [hosted by the USA Coaching Coalition](#), will be held June 19-21, 2012 in Indianapolis, IN. The theme for 2012 is **Sports - Take Part. Get Set for Life**. Athletics should provide to all who participate the opportunity to learn important lessons in life such as being responsible, demonstrating integrity, showing character and being a good citizen, to mention a few. Learning skills, tactics and life's lesson does not happen automatically. A coach must intentionally plan, teach and model for these outcomes to

occur.

Canadian Sport for Life (CS4L) is a movement to improve the quality of sport and physical activity in Canada. It links, sport, education, recreation and health and aligns community, provincial and national programming. Long Term Athlete Development (LTAD) is a seven-stage training, competition and recovery pathway guiding an individual's experience in sport and physical activity from infancy through all phases of adulthood. CS4L with LTAD represents a paradigm shift in the way Canadians lead and deliver sport and physical activity in Canada.
