Student Research Opportunities **AAHPERD National Convention 2011** **San Diego, California** **March 29-April 2, 2011** **Call for ABSTRACTS**

The 126th Annual Meeting of the American Alliance for Health, Physical Education, Recreation, and Dance will be held in San Diego, California during the week of March 29 - April 2. NASPE is proud to announce two different exciting opportunities for student research at the 2011 National Convention. Please carefully read about each opportunity to decide which one is right for you or your student.

OPPORTUNITY 1:

NASPE Undergraduate Research Posters

Students interested in presenting their *completed* research at the Convention are eligible as part of the NASPE Research Poster Session. Poster abstracts will undergo a *peer-reviewed* process and the names of the presenters of selected abstracts will appear in the *AAHPERD Convention Program*.

Abstracts must be submitted electronically to H. Scott Kieffer at kieffer@messiah.edu and received by 5:00pm EST by **October 31, 2010**. Abstracts received prior to the deadline will undergo peer-review and notification of acceptance will occur by November 15, 2010. If accepted for the poster session, the date and time of the session will be sent to the first author of the abstract once the final program for the convention has been established. The names of accepted student abstracts will appear in the AAHPERD Convention Program.

Students and advisors are encouraged to submit research that has been previously presented at state and/or regional professional meetings. Research presented at any national convention/conference may not be submitted.

Submission Criteria for Completed Undergraduate Research

1. An undergraduate student **MUST** be the first author on the poster.
2. The first author must attend the AAHPERD Annual Meeting and have paid the appropriate registration fees for the AAHPERD Annual Meeting.
3. The first author **MUST** be present during the entire session to answer questions or discuss the findings.
4. Each person is only permitted to submit and be first author on one abstract. The student and advisor may be co-authors on multiple abstracts.

5. All submissions must be sponsored by a faculty member. The faculty member's name and e-mail address must be clearly indicated on the submission form.

Abstract Format Instructions for Completed Undergraduate Research

1. All research MUST be completed. The results and discussion may not indicate that results will be discussed during the time of the presentation.
2. All abstracts should include a **Purpose, Methods, Results, and Conclusion**. These should be included in the abstract (in bold type) to delineate sections of the abstract.
3. The title of the article should be limited to 10 words
4. All authors should be listed in order of work or effort placed in the study and the institutional affiliation of the authors should immediately follow the listing of authors.
5. All abstracts MUST be submitted using Microsoft Word (PC-format preferred)
6. All abstracts must be written in English.
7. Submit all abstracts to kieffer@messiah.edu
8. **Abstracts not meeting the above format instructions will not be accepted.**

OPPORTUNITY 2:

Research Consortium/National Association Student Works In Progress Research Posters

Through this professional development opportunity sponsored by the Research Consortium, in collaboration with the National Associations of AAHPERD, students can illustrate ongoing/unfinished research and get feedback from experienced scholars in their area. Since the research projects are in various stages of completion, these presentations will not be peer-reviewed and thus, names will not be included in the program. Participation in this poster session will be on a first come first served basis. This session will be open to students at the undergraduate, masters and doctoral levels. More details will be available in **October, 2010**.
