NΔA Chapters are established to recognize and promote dance education within the school and community. With the Advisor's leadership, students expand their vision of service through the arts and academics.

- Provides student dancers with an honor society specifically focused on dance
- Recognizes scholarly and artistic achievements
- Provides opportunities to be published in the NΔA Journal
- Allows for networking with other NΔA members and dance professionals
- Provides credentials to assist with future endeavors
- Increases venues to showcase students' choreographic projects
- Allows students to mentor and hone teaching skills in community service and leadership activities

Establishing Your Nu Delta Alpha Chapter

Each Chapter must have an Advisor approved by the governing officer of your institution (head, principal, dean, department chair, director). The Advisor must be a member of the National Dance Association (NDA). The organization may choose to become an institutional member, and in doing so, the Advisor may represent the institution as its NDA member and receive associated benefits. There is no term limit for advisors.

The institution must submit a completed Letter of Commitment and Chapter Registration Form along with a brief description of the institution, its dance program and a short resume of the Chapter Advisor to the National Dance Association Headquarters.

Student Membership Eligibility

Criteria for membership selection requires that students

- Maintain a B (3.0) average
- Be actively involved in dance activities
- Earn points toward initiation as a full member
- Attend Nu Delta Alpha meetings and activities

A student may be accepted into a Chapter if s/he has recently transferred from another educational institution.
