- a. Sponsor's Statement (importance of scholarly work) (*1/2 page*)
- b. Personal Data (*1/4 page*)
- c. Education (*1/4 page*)
- d. Professional Experience (*1/2 page*)
- e. Honors (international, national, state, etc.) (*1/2 page*)
- f. Publications (provide a summary before listing under separate categories:
 - (I) books or monographs
 - (II) refereed articles
 - (III) abstracts
 - (IV) chapters in books, etc
 - (V) non-refereed articles*(maximum limit of six (6) pages)*
- g. Creative Activities (choreography, dance presentations, literary works, artistic media productions, etc.)
- h. Invited Presentations (limit to the fifteen most important and summarize as to level, etc., national *(maximum of one (1) page)*)
- i. Professional Organizations and Activities (indicate membership, offices held, and years of service) *(maximum of one (1) page)*

NOTE: the entire submission should not exceed ten (10) pages.

Scholar Program:
